

CITY OF RITTMAN
APPLICATION FOR WATER SERVICE
ORDINANCE 971.3 & 931.1

The Subscriber requests the City of Rittman to supply water at _____ Rittman, OH 44270.
owned by the subscriber, agrees to the following regulations of the City:

1. The City will supply water only through its meters. If the meter is tested upon the subscriber's request or otherwise and is found to vary from accuracy in excess of five percent (5%) plus or minus, the City agrees to proportionately adjust or credit the account based on a period no exceeding thirty (30) days prior to the test.
2. If a meter shall fail to register water as it passes through, the subscriber shall pay such an amount as the City shall estimate on the basis of the average bill paid for the preceding three (3) months or during the time the consumer has used water if he shall not have used water for a period of three (3) months.
3. The subscriber insures and saves the City harmless against loss of water, injury, or damage; and will upon request of the City deposit with the City such sums of money as the City may require as security.
4. If the meter shall be lost, damaged, removed, or reset, the City may replace, repair or reset the meter and charge that expense to the subscriber. This expense shall become payable with the next monthly water bill.
5. The subscriber agrees that only the City and its agent, shall set, remove, or repair meters.
6. The City shall have access to the premise of the subscriber for the purpose of setting, removing, inspection or reading the meter at least once per year.
7. The City shall have the right to shut-off the supply of water for the nonpayment of any bill for water or sewer, for replacing or repairing meters.
8. The subscriber recognizes that they alone are responsible for the lines from the street to the meter and for the plumbing on their premises. Subscriber shall pay for all water passing through their meter and they agree to keep their service pipe from the main to the meter free from leaks. In the event that they fail to do so, the City shall have the right to shut-off the water at the main and charge them for such expense as a condition precedent to their right to resume service.
9. If the subscribers' water is turned off at the curb box for non-payment, repairs, or at the subscriber's request, the City will not be responsible for any water leaks due to deterioration or inferior plumbing. This also applies to repair or replacement of water meter.
10. Bills will be mailed to the property owner, who will be held directly responsible for the payment of all bills for the use of water and sewer charges and fees.
11. Failure to receive a bill will not relieve the owner of the responsibility for prompt payment of the bill.
